

INTERNSHIP PLACEMENT FAQ

1. What kind of commitment does NYFS expect of interns?

We ask that all our interns commit to 20 hours a week for a full year. We also ask that you are able to work 2 evenings a week until 8pm.

2. Does NYFS offer paid internships?

Internships at NYFS are unpaid. However, many interns go on to become full time employees at NYFS after they complete their internship.

3. What does supervision look like?

Interns and agency clinicians meet once a week for a group consultation. Interns also meet once a week with an approved supervisor for 1:1 supervision.

4. How many clients will I see?

The typical caseload for an intern is 10-14 clients a week.

5. Do I start seeing clients right away?

The first two weeks of your placement will be orientation only. You will likely shadow therapy sessions and intakes, but you will not see a client of your own until your third week at the agency.
